<p>Application Requirements for International Students</p>	<p>International students must enter to the following link for the application form (Student form 2024-02) and submit the following documents to complete their applications:</p> <p>In case the student is ONLINE modality:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🔴 Letter of presentation from their home university: stating semesters the student will be studying at UPC and the academic program they are currently enrolled in at their home institution. 🔴 Passport or ID copy. <p>In case the student is ON-site modality: (Student Visa Application) Send the international Office contact analyst in a ZIP. All documents must be in PDF.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🔴 Copy of passport. (Mandatory passport in face-to-face modality. 🔴 Air tickets or ticket reservations (Mandatory in case the student makes your face-to-face exchange) 🔴 International Insurance (mandatory in case the student makes your face-to-face exchange) with the dates corresponding to the semester 2024 02. 🔴 Letter of economic solvency: Letter from the bank institution or legal guardian sustaining your living cost in Peru. 🔴 Cover letter from home university or transcript. <p>Visa consulate information: Consulados Perú. Please us know in what consulate you're willing to pick up your visa n the document delivered email</p> <p>Note: the applicants must be enrolled in their home university.</p>
<p>UPC Acceptance Letter</p>	<p>After receiving the student's application, the admission committee will review the documents and the Letter of Acceptance will be sent by email to your home institution. The process may take a couple of weeks.</p>

<p>Language of instruction</p>	<p>Spanish, English (courses upon request)</p>
<p>Language Requirements</p>	<p>Intermediate Spanish (B1) International certificate not need it.</p>
<p>English courses</p>	<p>UPC's English course catalogue can vary every semester. The list of English courses provided by UPC will be provided based on request.</p>
<p>Course information</p>	<p>Course syllabi will be sent via e-mail to applicants. Applicants must indicate the UPC program, course name and UPC code. Courses agenda its determine by the academic area not by the International Oficce.</p>
<p>Minimum courses international students should be enrolled in</p>	<p>1 course (aprox. 3 credits)</p>
<p>Official Transcripts – UPC</p>	<p>UPC will issue official academic transcripts roughly one month after the end of classes. Official academic transcripts will be sent via e-mail in digital format to the International Office of the foreign institution.</p>
<p>Grading Scale</p>	<p>Grading scale in Peru runs from 0 to 20, 20 being the maximum score. Passing grade in Peru is set at 11 but at UPC it has been set at 13 to ensure academic exigency.</p>
<p>Credits</p>	<p>At UPC, courses usually are worth 3 to 4 credits. Rough conversion to ECTS: 1 UPC credit = 2 ECTS.</p>
<p>Changes to course schedules</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🔴 Once the online course registration process is completed, students will not be able to make changes to their courses. 🔴 Any changes in schedules, withdrawal from courses or the full semester will be free of charge during the first 6 weeks of start of classes.
